Coexistence With Ever-Changing Earth

A gigantic eruption created the Toya caldera and its surrounding plateau. Later, the volcanic domes Nakajima and Usu volcano were born. Such geological evolution offers beautiful scenery and attractive sites for farming and geotourism. Indigenous Jomon-Ainu people developed a unique culture in harmony with the ever-changing nature of the region. We also follow this path of coexistence with the active earth. You can easily visit and learn about unbelievable ground deformations such as Showa-Shinzan. Hot springs and delicious farmed and marine foods also welcome you.



Historic Site Irie-Takasago Shell Mound

The Irie-Takasago Shell Mound is a settlement site including shell mounds located on high ground overlooking Uchiura Bay. It dates from the Early to Final Jomon periods (5,000 to 2,800 years ago). The Irie Shell Mound yielded the remains of many pit dwellings and a total of 44 graves, providing a glimpse into the use of shell mounds as special places for burial by Jomon period people. In July 2021, the Irie Shell Mound and the Takasago Shell Mound were inscribed on the UNESCO World Cultural Heritage List as component parts of the Jomon Prehistoric Sites in Northern Japan.



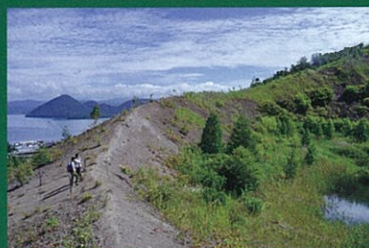
SPRING

Spring is a refreshing season in which the ground thaws and plants start to bud. From around May onward, flowers begin blooming and the mountains are covered with fresh greenery.

Illuminated Tunnel

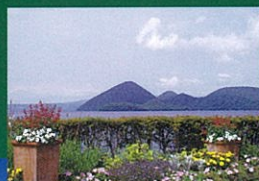
Visitors can walk through this fantastic tunnel of light in the Toyako spa area that measures approximately 70 meters.

In summer, Toyako Onsen is ablaze with flowers.

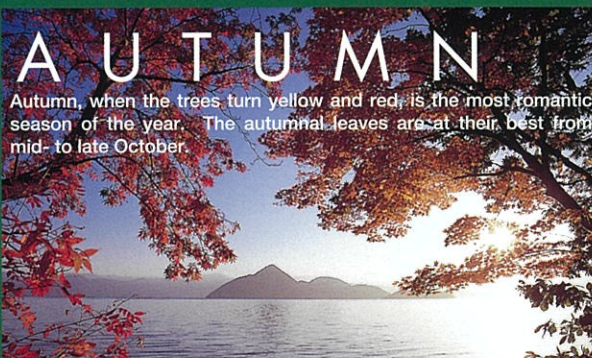


Summer is the most beautiful season in Lake Toya. Between June and August, the lake is enveloped in colorful flowers and fresh greenery.

Autumn, when the trees turn yellow and red, is the most romantic season of the year. The autumnal leaves are at their best from mid- to late October.



Lake Toya

An almost round caldera, Lake Toya extends approximately 11 km east to west, 9 km south to north and measures about 43km around, 70.7km² in area and 179m in maximum water depth. It is the ninth largest lake in the nation and the third largest of the caldera lakes. There are four islands at the center of the lake, including the large, scenic Nakajima. Toyako Town, the location of Lake Toya, played host to the 2008 G8 Summit at which the leaders of the world's industrialized nations assembled. In addition, the nearby Mt. Usu has been certified as a Japanese Geopark in recognition of its status as a natural park blessed with outstanding geological heritage. Stone Age archeological remains were discovered in the vicinity and have been nominated as a candidate to become a World Heritage Site. This combination of interesting features has brought Lake Toya increased attention worldwide.



Mt. Usu

Mt.Usu is a symbolic mountain located on the south side of Lake Toya. The mountain is one of the most active volcanoes in Hokkaido, with repeated eruptions on a cycle of between 20 and 50 years. Its most recent eruption was in 2000.



Showa Shinzan

A relatively new mountain formed by two years of volcanic activity after volcanic smoke appeared from a wheat field in June 1944 following an earthquake that had occurred in December 1943. The mountain is designated as a special national natural monument due to its value in the academic field.



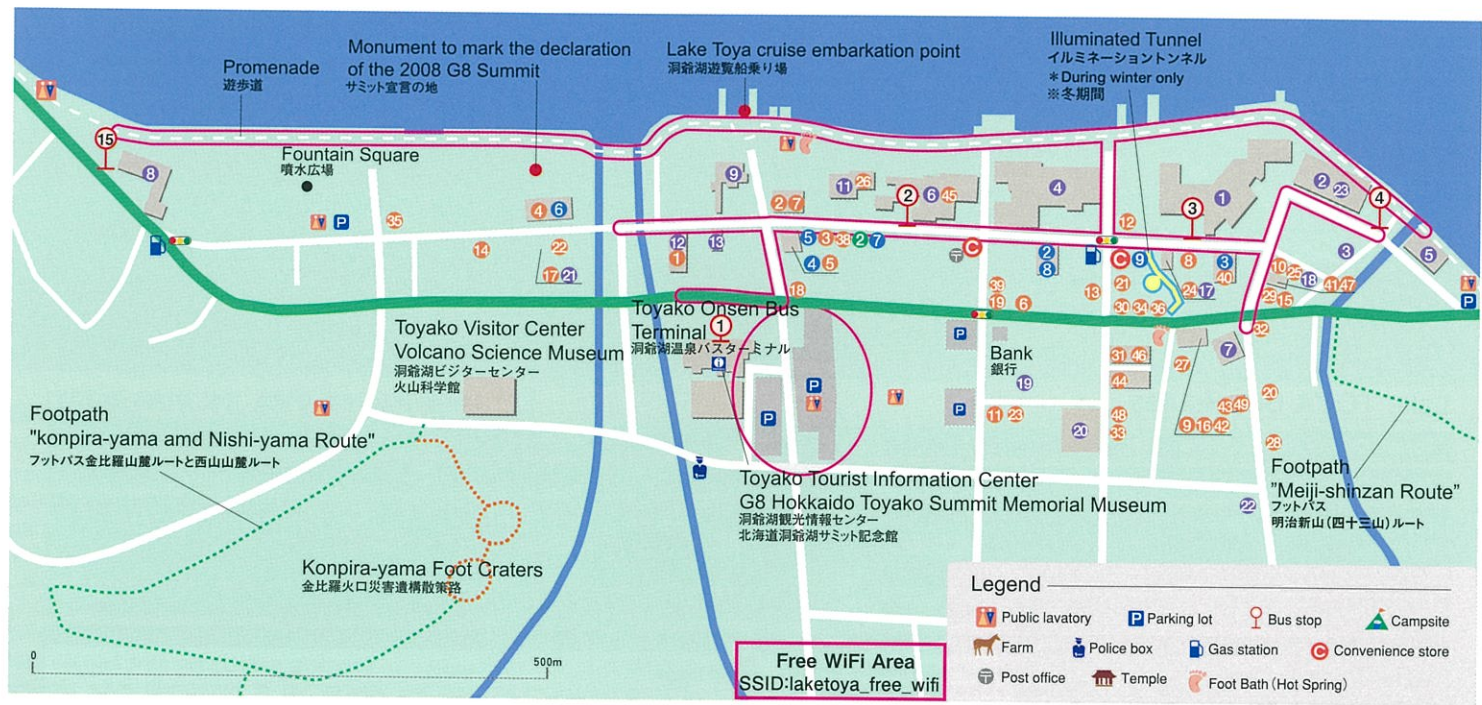
Lake TOYA AREAMAP

Konpira Crater-Remnants of the Disaster Walking Trail

Located near the Toyoko Onsen Area, many remains, including buildings destroyed by volcanic eruptions and bridges washed away by the mudflow, can be observed up close.

Yokozuna Kitanoumi Memorial Hall

Kitanoumi, a sumo wrestler who played an active part as the strongest yokozuna in the Japanese national sport of Sumo, is originally from Sobetsu Town. His match records and materials related to him are preserved and displayed.

Sobetsu Park

There is an observatory here from which views over Mt. Yotei, Mt. Usu and Showa Shinzan can be commanded. Plum blossoms open in early May, and the area is famous for its plum groves.



Showa Shinzan Bear Park

Home to approximately 70 two-meter-long brown bears. Gives a sense of the powerful ecology of bears that cannot be observed in cages at zoos.

Usuzan Ropeway

The 106-seater-gondola ride takes roughly six minutes either way between Showa Shinzan Station and the top of Mt. Usu. From the observatory at the summit of the mountain, Lake Toya, Mt. Yotei and Uchiura Bay can be observed. In addition, the crater of Mt. Usu, which still emits smoke, can be watched at close range. The Usu Volcano South Rim Trail is also available for walking. This is one of the footpath routes where visitors can enjoy strolling by Lake Toya.

Ukimido Park

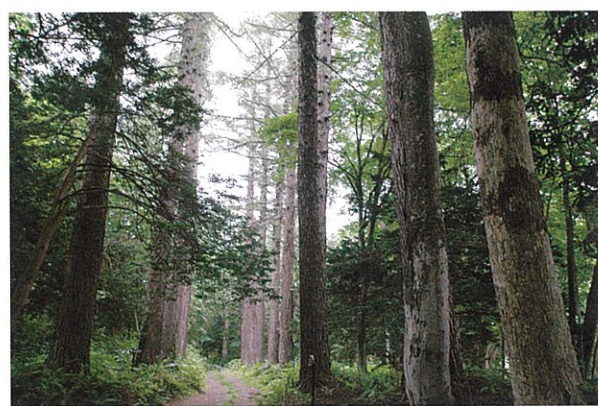

Summit at Lake Toya

Lake Toya is located in the Shikotsu-Toya National Park, and its natural scenery was formed by volcanic activity. Since the area is easy to get around and is close to large cities while maintaining the natural area around the lake, many people visit this area to commune with nature. Thanks to the beauty of the environment, the area was selected as the site of the 34th G8 Summit held in 2008.



Toyako Specialty' Long-run Fireworks

Lake Toya has 20-minute firework displays of approximately 450 fireworks every night between the end of April and the end of October. The fireworks are launched by pyrotechnicians on a boat on the lake. The displays can be admired from all hotels on the lakeside in the Toyako Onsen area. Although Japanese people love fireworks, Lake Toya is the nation's only place where the firework display season is so long.



Noren

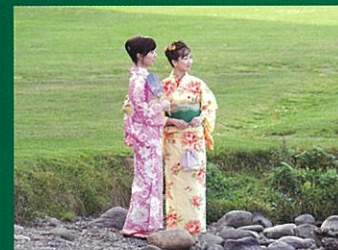
A noren is a fabric banner often hung at restaurant entrances. Although the original noren was used to block wind, light and cold, it is now considered a sign of a restaurant being open. While shops are closed or preparing to open, the noren is placed inside the restaurant or turned backward. Thus, when a noren is present, the shop is open, meaning "Irasshaimase (welcome to our shop)."



Try wearing a yukata

A yukata is a traditional Japanese robe made of thin light cloth. It is easier to put on than a kimono. Although it was originally used as a bathrobe, in modern times many people wear yukata at public events or festivals. Many accommodation facilities provide yukata, and many hotels rent more fashionable and colorful ones than their standard versions.

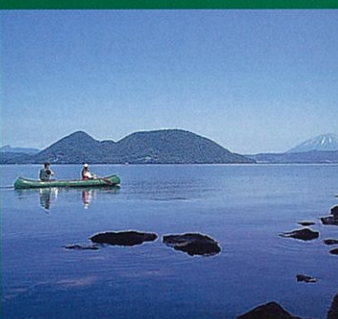
Since hotel staff can help guests to dress, why not wear a yukata and walk around the hot spring area?



Enjoy the four seasons and experience nature by bathing in hot springs

Spring with its many blooming flowers, the green of summer, the hue of autumn leaves and winter with its powdery snow. The seasons are clearly defined in the Toyako area, where hot springs can be enjoyed in the rich nature of every season.

There are many courses for walking, where visitors can casually commune with nature. The provision of a range of outdoor sports such as canoeing and horse trekking gives visitors the chance to work up a sweat through athletic pursuits. After their outdoor activities, guests can relax in a hot spring. Information on nature in the Toyako area is provided at the Toyako Visitor Center.

Hot springs contain various mineral components that are absorbed by the body and bring medicinal effects to promote health. Eleven hot springs are dotted around Lake Toya, and the qualities of the springs in the Lake Toya and Sobetsu areas (where lots of Japanese-style hotels and accommodation facilities stand side by side) are said to be effective in relieving cuts, peripheral circulatory disorders, poor blood circulation, depression and xeroderma.

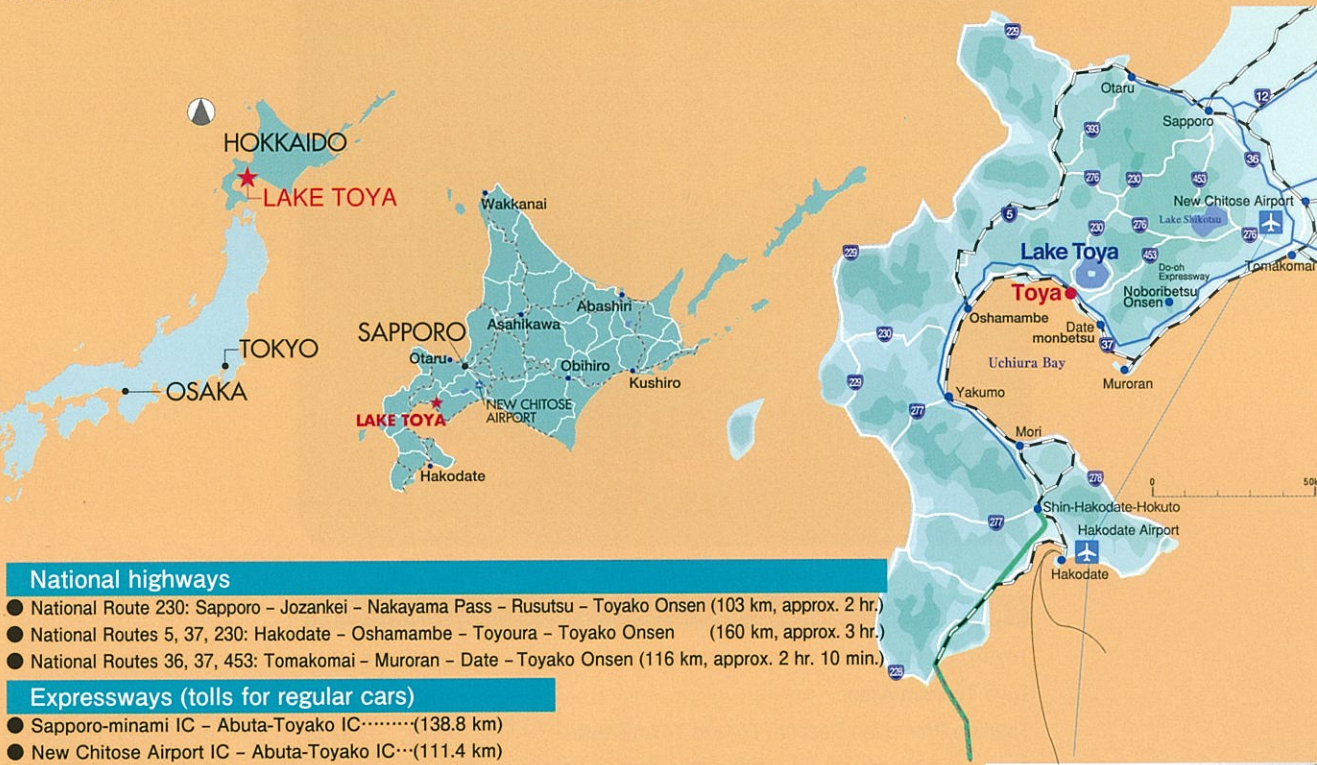
